A letter will be sent out next week

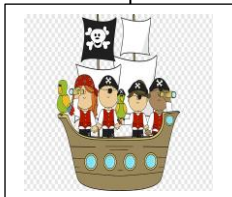

No younger siblings allowed

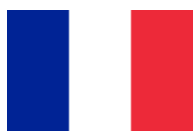


## Bastille Day Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July
