The school dates are published on our school website a year in advance.

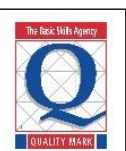

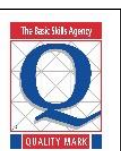

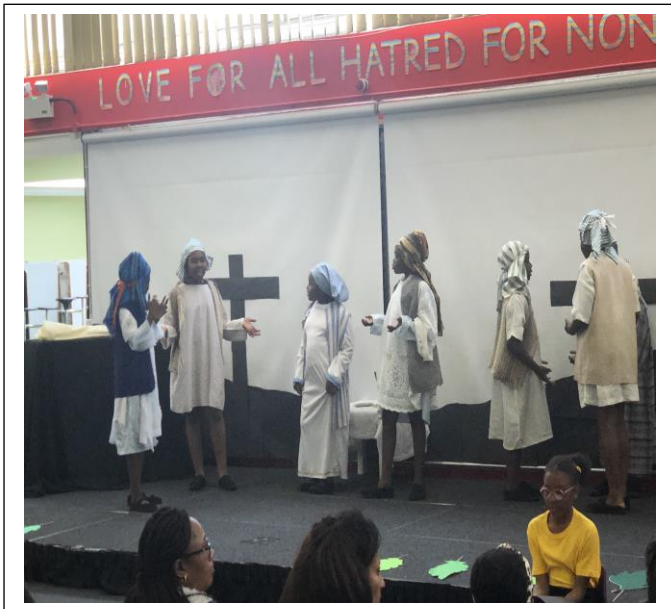
